It ties in well with the Summer Reading theme - Adventure Begins at Your Library and the Suffolk County Summer Tour. Kids can read books, do activities to receive badges, and earn prizes.

On May 2nd, I attended Book Buzz Long Island (an online presentation through SCLS) where I learned about recent and upcoming books for children and teens. While many of the titles haven't been published yet, I was able to purchase some of them through our donation of Bobby's Books. (I also set up carts in Ingram that include some of the titles from this presentation in hopes that the next librarian purchases them.)
